We will visit the ancient Andalusian cities of Cordoba, Granada, Seville, Ronda: all UNESCO world Heritage sites. We will stay in old palaces and historic buildings converted into Paradores and 4*Hotels, including the Parador in Granada, located high up by the Alhambra Palace.

This tour will consider the fascinatingly rich and diverse history of Andalusia, represented by its art and architecture, commissioned by Imperial and Holy Roman Emperors, Islamic caliphs, Renaissance kings and conquerors of South America, to cultural icons such as Picasso.
